-	Treasurer's Update (note: all numbers are rounded) Revenue for 2014-15 was around £41,000, including donations to the school of £5,000 and £3,000 (the latter for microscopes as part of the Spring Ball Fund raising). During the year, payments to the school were £43,000 plus the £8,000 above.

 Updates (cont'd) 1. Treasurer's Update cont'd The current bank balance of £18,000 includes £3,000 of uncleared expenses and some on-going commitments to the school so a free balance of £13,000. Events have generally been profitable with the Christmas Rafle making £2,400, the Fun Day over £5,000 and an additional £3,000 from the Raffle. The PA Ball made £5,000 with £3,000 (as mentioned above for microscopes). Magic Night made £1,300, Lost Property £2,300 and the Year 7 Quiz £1,000.

3. School Wish List After some discussion, £810 was committed for three teams to the National Land Rover Competition.
