| Updates <br> 1. Treasurer's Update (note: all numbers are rounded) Revenue for 2014-15 was around $£ 41,000$, including donations to the school of $£ 5,000$ and $£ 3,000$ (the latter for microscopes as part of the Spring Ball Fund raising). During the year, payments to the school were $£ 43,000$ plus the $£ 8,000$ above. |  |

| Updates (cont'd) <br> 1. Treasurer's Update cont'd The current bank balance of $£ 18,000$ includes $£ 3,000$ of uncleared expenses and some on-going commitments to the school so a free balance of $£ 13,000$. Events have generally been profitable with the Christmas Rafle making $£ 2,400$, the Fun Day over $£ 5,000$ and an additional $£ 3,000$ from the Raffle. The PA Ball made $£ 5,000$ with $£ 3,000$ (as mentioned above for microscopes). Magic Night made $£ 1,300$, Lost Property $£ 2,300$ and the Year 7 Quiz $£ 1,000$. <br> 2. Mock Tests. <br> We need to write to HMRC to confirm that we will be exempt from VAT and the consultant has quoted a price of $£ 120+$ VAT so just under $£ 150$. This was approved. <br> 3. School Wish List <br> After some discussion, $£ 810$ was committed for three teams to the National Land Rover Competition. Associated with this, we expect the Y13 team to assist with a Raffle where the prize will be the Driving Lessons that the PA has received. In addition, $£ 360$ was committed to the Economics department for their Economics 2.0 competition, similar to last year.
